

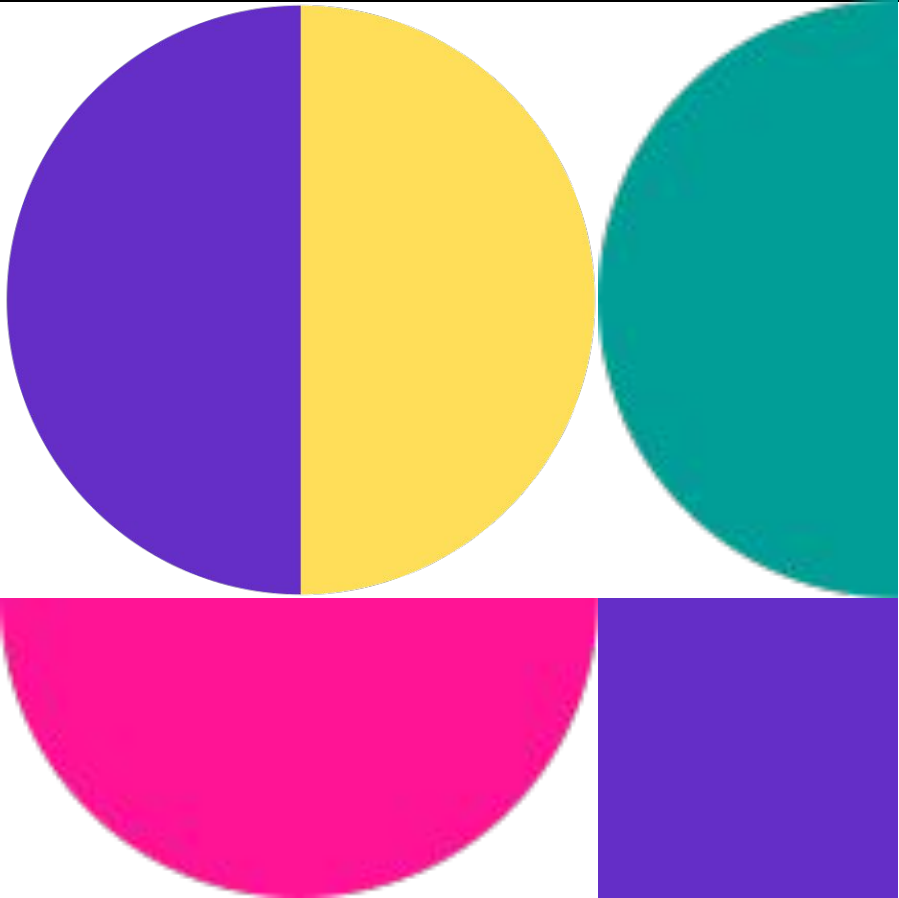

- Know that we may need to agree to disagree

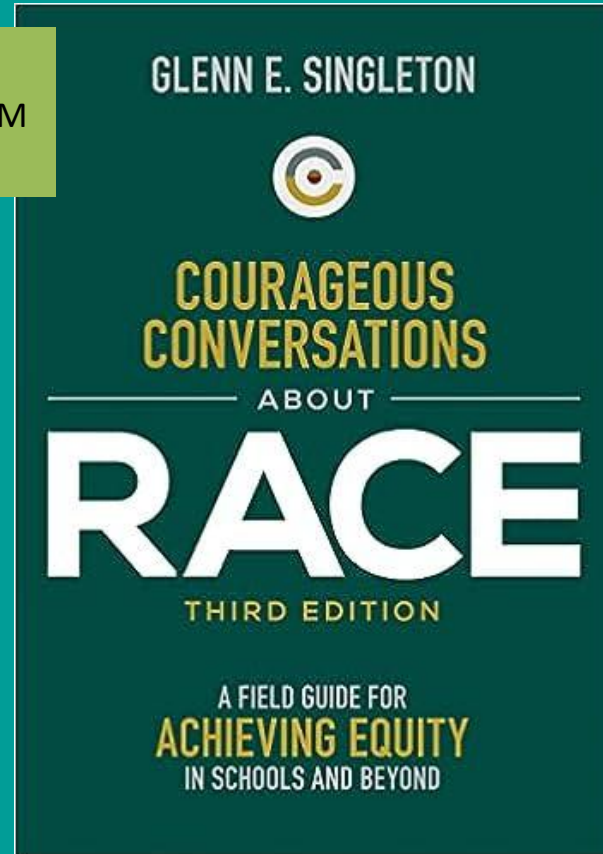

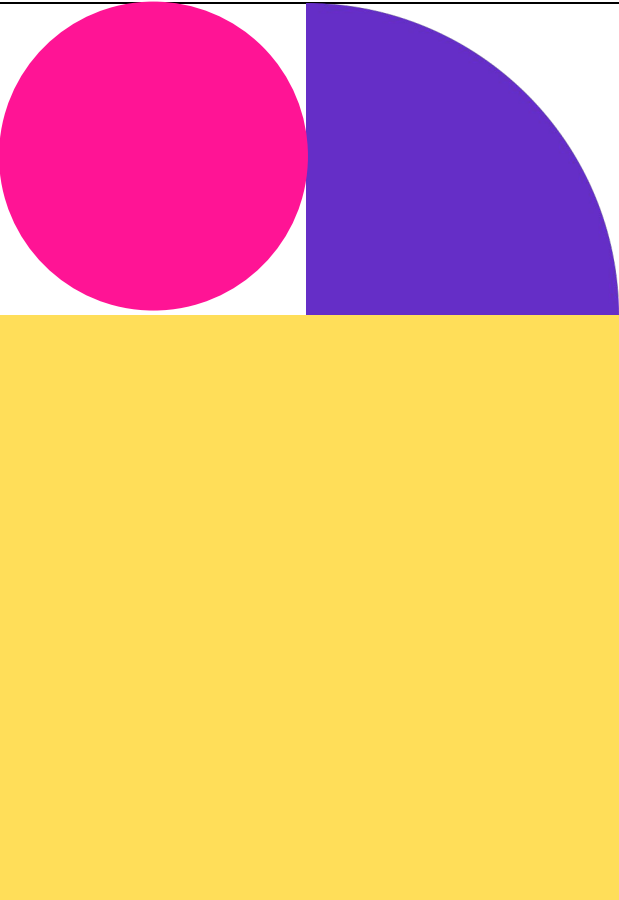

Update by Lindsey on CCAR grant proposal

We are writing a grant proposal to bring in CCAR training for our Red Hawk leadership, staff, EDI, PTO/FSO, families, and the community (other school leadership roles within Erie SVVSD, PTOs, DEI teams, and higher leadership in SVVSD). The proposal will be for 2 in-person 6 hour days of CCAR training (Courageous Conversations About Race), and we have been quoted \$18,500 for the event. We are writing the grant for the full amount.

Grants to Communities

Community organizations may apply to the Town for financial and in-kind support of projects, programs, and events. The grants assume an annual cycle to allow for appropriate budgeting and planning. The [online application](#) for the 2024 grant cycle will open September 1, 2023.

Award Criteria

All applications for Grant Awards will be reviewed based upon how well the stated purpose for the request serves the Town's residents in relation to general criteria that is stated in the [policies and procedures](#).

Eligibility

Eligibility is restricted to applicants which are:

- Recognized community service organizations organized and federally designated for tax purposes as non-profit corporations (501c3).
- Chartered chapters of state or national lodges or service organizations that engage in charitable or community service activities.
- Public schools located in Erie.

Application

Applications for funding are accepted from Sept. 1 through Nov. 30 for funding of events or programs in the following year. Requests must be submitted online using the [Grant Application](#). Recipients of grant funds will receive notice of award by January 30, 2024.

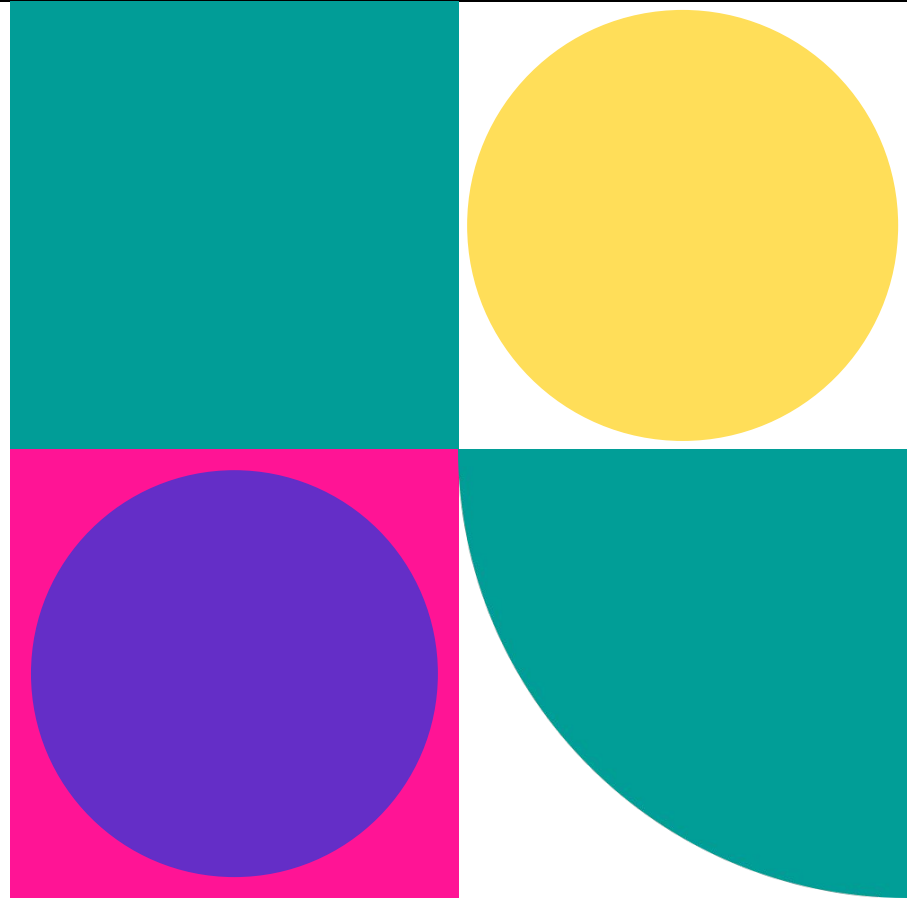
